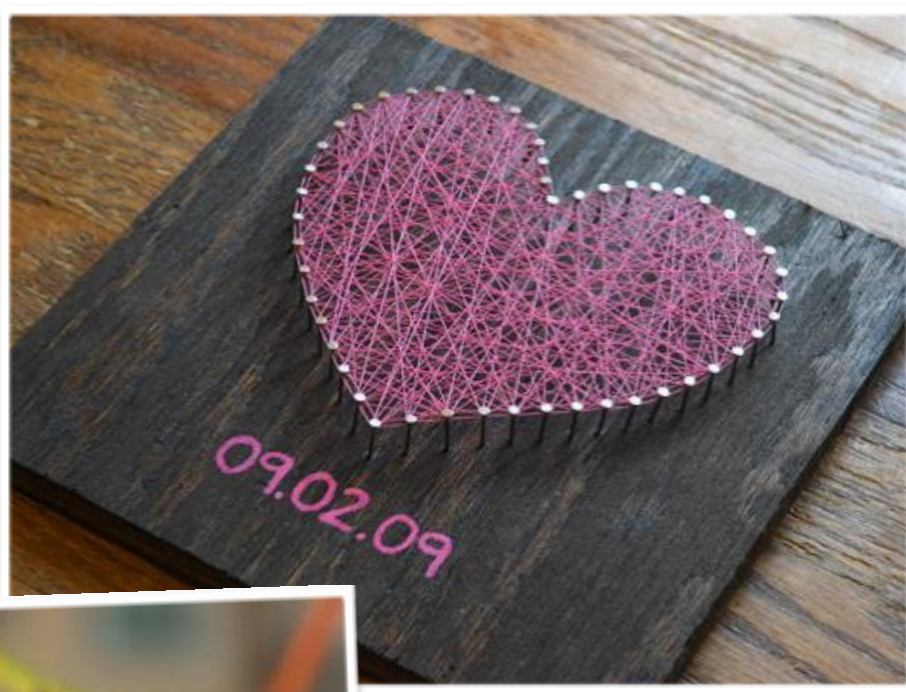


Art Thinking Art Making

Introduction

The camp is opened to children from 6 to 11 years old and runs from 8.30am to 4.30pm, with the possibility to choose between the whole day option or the half day option until 12.30pm, after lunch.

It will be all about Wood and Wool and the different techniques children can use to create original works of art using these two natural materials.

Students will work on big collective projects as well as on individual projects. Everything will be displayed in St. Thomas More Art Gallery and in the outdoor space around the building for everybody to enjoy it.

The main focus and goal of the camp is having the children being able to experience the deep connection between arts and environment and having them creating original works of art that can have an impact on the community.
